Driving a motor vehicle to school is a privilege offered by the parents and the school to responsible students. Failure to abide by school rules may result in temporary or permanent loss of privileges. Students must provide a copy of their driver's license. Students requesting a parking permit must also consent to random drug testing as provided by JCISD Board Policy FNF(LOCAL). A separate signed consent form must be on file in the LBJHS office before a parking permit will be issued.

Parking regulations requires all vehicles driven to school by students exhibit an LBJ parking tag acquired through the Student Council for a fee of \$10.00. Permits may not be transferred to another student. If for unforeseen reasons, you drive a different vehicle to school, the tag must be transferred to the new vehicle. Failure to drive a tagged or identified vehicle will result in disciplinary action.

Improper operation of a vehicle on campus, which will not be tolerated, includes but is not limited to: excessive speed, noise, reckless driving, improper take-off and/or texting/talking on cell phone while driving on campus. Students providing their own transportation to and from school assume total responsibility for arriving on time to classes. Students should not expect excused tardies or absences for personal car trouble. Student parking is limited to the numbered spaces in front of the school. Students may not park in back of school.

All vehicles parked on school property, parking lots, etc... shall be subject to a search at any time. Students are responsible for anything found in their vehicles.

Failure to follow the guidelines for operation of a vehicle on campus may result in loss of driving privileges and/or additional disciplinary consequence(s) according to the JCISD Student Code of Conduct.

This form is to be completed and returned during the first 10 days of school if the student is a licensed driver requesting permission to park on campus at the start of the school year.
